## Screening and Curriculum:

In addition to vision and speech screenings, teachers score parent screenings on their children upon entry to LCC and assess their progression on an ongoing basis.

## Lower Ratios and Group Sizes:

This means that teachers have more time to support your child's individual development and learning. 85% of brain development occurs by the time your child is three years old and the number of words your child knows when they enter kindergarten is the single most important predictor of school success.

Service providers such as Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, and Adapted Physical Education Teachers work on-site with both typical and special needs children.
